For Scarborough woman Vicki Templeman, the creation of a bright, welcoming space is the greatest gift this community could have given to people undergoing rehabilitation at Redcliffe Hospital.

Celebrating the results of Raise it for Redcliffe Hospital's three-year long, \$200,000 fundraising campaign, Vicki and her family thanked donors for the Rehabilitation and Stroke Unit's uplifting makeover.

"You can't believe the difference somewhere like this can make – the world of difference," says Vicki.

Admitted to hospital following a major stroke, Vicki's prognosis was devastating. But after specialist treatment in Redcliffe Hospital Coronary Care, and four months of intensive rehabilitation, she beat the odds to return home to her life as a doting mother and grandmother.

"The staff were amazing. They were like family," says Vicki's son, Ben. "Mum loves the thought that if anyone else has to be in the Rehabilitation Unit, they now have a lovely garden to enjoy and a beautiful cafe-style lounge to spend time with family during recovery."

Redcliffe Hospital Nurse Unit Manager Amelia Hadley says these touches of home, made possible by your donations, help both patients and their families.

"The recent renovations in the Rehabilitation and Acute Stroke Unit, of the dining and lounge room and garden courtyard, now provide comfortable, inviting spaces for patients and their families to come together," says Amelia.

66 These spaces help patients through their recovery, making their health journey more manageable while being away from home. 99


The celebrations paid tribute to the community leadership of past and present Redcliffe Hospital Giving Day Impact Partners and other key supporters.

Nursing and midwifery research is a winner for patients

As Redcliffe Hospital's first-ever Senior Nursing and Midwifery Researcher, Associate Professor Amanda Fox encourages nurses and midwives to conduct their own research – an invaluable opportunity made possible through your generosity.

"I enable clinicians from a range of disciplines to build capacity to investigate and test solutions to problems that they face in their area of work," says A/Prof Fox.

"The healthcare professionals involved are working at the coalface every day. Many use a co-design approach, including consumers in their project to ensure research meets what's important to patients."

Three years since A/Prof Fox was appointed, research projects launched include: evaluating the use of calming weighted blankets for patients with dementia; improving dental hygiene for patients who have experienced stroke; and improved treatment of pain for children in the Emergency Department.
